Direct Linking:

- From the BrainPOP movie page, copy the URL segment AFTER the .com from the URL displayed in the browser address bar, **as shown in red** in the examples below.
- Add the segment you copied to the end the appropriate **Direct Link stem highlighted below** in order to create the direct link. You are replacing the <http://www.brainpop.com> segment in the original URL with the highlighted Direct Link stem.

	<p>Direct Linking: Copy the URL displayed in the Internet Address bar of your browser.</p> <p>*Users may need to authenticate first by clicking on the CultureGrams icon in BCPS One > Digital Content before accessing the direct link.</p>
	<p>Direct Linking: Click on the Share arrow or the ellipsis (three dots) > Share to create a direct link to Discovery Education content.</p> <p>*Users will be prompted to log into BCPS One to access direct links to Discovery Ed content, if not logged into BCPS One or Schoology.</p>
 <p>Renamed GALE IN CONTEXT Elementary</p>	<p>Direct Linking: Click the Get Link button (image of a chain) on the horizontal navigation bar; an overlay window will open displaying the direct link URL.</p>
	<p>*First time users will be prompted to select their school; C & I Staff should select BCPS.</p> <p>Direct Linking: Click Copy on the top left toolbar, under the netTrekker logo; the netTrekker URL will be copied to your clipboard and ready to paste into Schoology or elsewhere for student access.</p> <p>*Users may need to authenticate first by clicking on the netTrekker icon in BCPS One > Digital Content before accessing the direct link.</p> <p>*Direct links open in the netTrekker frame, allowing student use of embedded learning supports (read-aloud, dictionary, translation).</p>

	<p>Direct Linking: Click on the Perm-link icon to copy the Permanent Link to the media asset. You can obtain a Permanent link to a Full Video, Chapter, Segment or a Playlist you've created.</p> <p>*When a permanent link is clicked, playback begins immediately after the BCPS user logs into Safari Montage.</p>
 	<p>Direct Linking:</p> <p>Display the TumbleBook title. Copy the URL from the browser address bar on the book's intro page, if you want students to be able to see the cover, read the synopsis, click Read Online, or access a Quiz or the Book Report form after reading.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ You can click Read Online and copy that URL, if you want to direct students directly inside the eBook without accessing the other resources. ▪ You can also create a direct link to a Video, Book Report, Quiz or Playlist by copying its URL from the browser address bar. <p>*Include a direction for students to authenticate by clicking TumbleBooks or TumbleBook Cloud Jr. icon on Digital Content tile in BCPS One before selecting the direct link.</p>
  	<p>Direct Linking: Navigate to the selected article. Copy the URL displayed in the Internet address bar of your browser.</p> <p>*Include a direction for students to authenticate by clicking the appropriate World Book icon on Digital Content tile in BCPS One before selecting the direct link.</p>
